Our offer

The Ukrainian partner universities are preparing a German-Ukrainian master program in logistics (GUMLog for short) with the University of Bremen, Germany. One part of this four-year collaboration is student mobility. In 2017 there are **six grants** available worth 750 euro each apart from a pre-booked air ticket. Exchange time - one month studying and one so-called orientation week during autumn semester 2017.

Nominated students will be expected to:

- participate at lectures and seminars, offered in English;
- learn German culture and language;
- contribute in line with one subject from the GUMLog curricula.

The nomination will be decided following a Skype interview. After nomination you will be supported to find accommodation and to apply for a visa.

- Reliable knowledge of English (30%)
- Motivation letter (30%)
- Transcript of academic records (20%)
- List of the lectures or seminars you wish to study in Bremen (10%)
- Correctness and completeness of application (10%)
